



### Synopsis #9: Show 2: Seals, Trumpets, Vials

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. [16] And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God, [17] Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned. [18] And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldst give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldst destroy them which destroy the earth. [19] And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. *Revelation 11:15-19*

The Seventh Trumpet is a description of the Wrath of God coming down on the Multitude and the conclusion of all things. The angry nations are describing the Serpents. Notice the lightnings, voices, thunderings, and an earthquake; the same description at the end of the Seven Vials and the end of the Seven Seals. The great hail is describing the 1st Trumpet

**Angry** 3710 from 3709; to provoke or enrage, i.e. (passively) become exasperated:--be angry (wroth).

**3709** from 3713; properly, desire (as a reaching forth or excitement of the mind), i.e. (by analogy), violent passion...anger, indignation, vengeance, wrath.

**3713** ...(compare 3735); to stretch oneself, i.e. reach out after (long for):--covet after, desire.

**3735**...perhaps akin to 142; compare 3733); a mountain (as lifting itself above the plain): -hill, mount(-ain).

**142** a primary root; to lift up; by implication, to take up or away; figuratively, to raise (the voice)...

**3733** ...a bird (as rising in the air), i.e. (specially), a hen (or female domestic fowl):--hen.

**And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ. Revelation 12:17**

**And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. Revelation 4:5**

**And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake. Revelation 8:5**

**And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 11:19**

**And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. Revelation 16:18**

**And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled. Exodus 19:16**

### **Voices**

**Voices** 5456...akin to 5316 through the idea of disclosure; a tone...saying or language:--noise, sound, voice.

**5316**...the base of 5457; to lighten (shine), i.e. show... appear, seem, be seen, shine, X think.

**5457** ...to shine or make manifest, especially by rays;... luminousness...fire, light.

### **Lightnings**

**For as the lightning, that lighteneth out of the one [part] under heaven, shineth unto the other [part] under heaven; so shall also the Son of man be in his day.**  
*Luke 17:24*

**For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.** *Matthew 24:27*

**Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west;** *Isaiah 43:5*

**Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executeth my counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.** *Isaiah 46:11*

**And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.** *Matthew 8:11*

**And they shall come from the east, and from the west, and from the north, and from the south, and shall sit down in the kingdom of God.** *Luke 13:29*

**If thy whole body therefore [be] full of light, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of light, as when the bright shining of a candle doth give thee light.** *Luke 11:36*

**Lightings 796** from 797; lightning; by analogy, glare:--lightning, bright shining.

**797** probably from 792; to flash as lightning:--lighten, shine.

**792** probably from the base of 4766; a star (as strown over the sky), literally or figuratively:--star.

**I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, [and] the bright and morning star.**  
*Revelation 22:16*

The Church of Thyatira: **And I will give him the morning star. 29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.** *Revelation 2:28*

**If thy whole body therefore [be] full of light, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of light, as when the bright shining of a candle doth give thee light.** *Luke 11:36*

**Light** from 5457; to shed rays, i.e. to shine or (transitively) to brighten up (literally or figuratively):--enlighten, illuminate, (bring to, give) light, make to see.

### **Thunderings**

**And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.** *Revelation 10:3*

**And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.** *Revelation 10:4*

**But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.** *Mark 13:11*

**But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.** *Revelation 10:7*

**Finished** 55 from 5056; to end, i.e. complete, execute, conclude, discharge (a debt):--accomplish, make an end, expire, fill up, finish...perform.

**5056** (to set out for a definite point or goal); properly, the point aimed at as a limit, i.e. (by implication) the conclusion of an act or state (termination (literally, figuratively or indefinitely)...specially, an impost or levy (as paid)...end...

**Also, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD unto the land of Israel; An end, the end is come upon the four corners of the land.** *Ezekiel 7:2*

**An end is come, the end is come: it watcheth for thee; behold, it is come.** *Ezekiel 7:6*

**But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. [14] And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.** *Matthew 24:13, 14*

**But take heed to yourselves: for they shall deliver you up to councils; and in the synagogues ye shall be beaten: and ye shall be brought before rulers and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them. [10] And the gospel must first be published among all nations.** *Mark 13:9, 10*

**Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, [52] In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.**  
*1 Corinthians 15:51, 52*

**For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: [17] Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.**  
*1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17*

**And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.** *Matthew 24:31*

**And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: [10] And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? [11] And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.** *Revelation 6:9 -11*
